I am requesting funding for the Cedar Avenue Recreation Complex Improvement Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Borough of Wenonah and the project will be located at 62 East Cedar Street, Wenonah NJ 08090. The funding will be used to make improvements to the Cedar Field Recreation Complex, including adding lighting instruments to the soccer field area which currently does not have permanent light fixtures; resurfacing the basketball court; adding two new pickleball courts; relocating the storage shed for recreation equipment to accommodate the new courts; replacing damaged safety netting at the softball field; and installing a new security camera system.
