Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the City of Camden for the “Morris-Delair Emergency Power Upgrade” project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Camden, located at 520 Market Street, Camden City, NJ 08101. The funding would be used to upgrade the facility’s emergency power and control infrastructure at the Morris-Delair wellfield near the former Puchack plant area along the Delaware River corridor. The project will replace and modernize key electrical systems that support plant operations and ensure reliable water production. Planned improvements include the installation of new generator switchgear, automatic transfer switches, and upgraded electrical distribution components that will allow the facility to seamlessly transition to backup power during outages. The project is valuable use of taxpayer funds because it protects critical public infrastructure that serves thousands of residents in Camden, New Jersey and surrounding communities.

This project has a Federal nexus as it is for the same purposes authorized in Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12
