1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Save Our Ships Act".
5	SEC. 2. HISTORIC NAVAL SHIP PRESERVATION GRANT PRO-
6	GRAM.

(a) Establishment.—There is established in the

8 Department of the Interior the Historic Naval Ship Pres-

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1	ervation Grant Program to support the physical preserva-
2	tion of historic military vessels, ensuring the continued
3	availability of these vessels to the American public to edu-
4	cate on the past and inspire the future of United States
5	military maritime endeavors.
6	(b) Administration.—The Program shall be admin-
7	istered by the Secretary, in consultation with the Depart-
8	ment of Homeland Security and the Department of De-
9	fense.
10	(c) Grant Uses.—In carrying out the Program, the
11	Secretary may award grants, on a competitive basis, to
12	eligible entities for the following activities:
13	(1) Conserving and preserving historic military
14	vessels at covered sites, including—
15	(A) physical upkeep and repair of the ves-
16	sels; and
17	(B) mitigating environmental hazards or
18	damage to the vessels.
19	(2) Implementing education and workforce de-
20	velopment programs related to military maritime ca-
21	reers, including shipbuilding and submarine con-
22	struction.
23	(d) Eligible Entities.—
24	(1) In General.—In carrying out the Pro-
25	gram, the Secretary may award grants to a unit of

1	State or local government or a private nonprofit or
2	ganization that administers a covered site.
3	(2) APPLICATION.—To be eligible for a grant
4	under the Program, an organization that admin-
5	isters a covered site shall submit to the Secretary ar
6	application at such time, in such manner, and con-
7	taining such information as the Secretary may re-
8	quire.
9	(e) Authorization of Appropriations.—There is
10	authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry
11	out the Program \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2025 and each
12	fiscal year thereafter.
13	(f) DEFINITION.—In this Act:
14	(1) COVERED SITE.—The term "covered site"
15	means a museum, memorial, monument, educational
16	center, or other venue that provides public access to
17	or publicly displays, a historic military vessel.
18	(2) HISTORIC MILITARY VESSEL.—The term
19	"historic military vessel" means a vessel that has
20	been decommissioned or otherwise removed from
21	service and—
22	(A) was owned and operated by the De-
23	partment of Defense or the Coast Guard, other
24	than a time- or voyage-chartered vessel;

1	(B) was owned and operated by the De-
2	partment of Transportation and designated by
3	the Secretary of the department in which the
4	Coast Guard is operating as a vessel equivalent
5	to a vessel described in subparagraph (A); or
6	(C) was built for, or pursuant to a contract
7	with, the United States Maritime Commission
8	or other legacy branch of the Department of
9	Transportation and at some point in the ves-
10	sel's service was equipped with armaments and
11	embarked Navy Armed Guard personnel to op-
12	erate the armaments.
13	(3) Program.—The term "Program" means
14	the Historic Naval Ship Preservation Grant Pro-
15	gram established by subsection (a).
16	(4) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
17	the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-
18	rector of the National Park Service.
